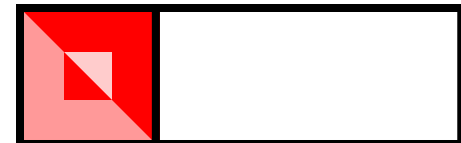

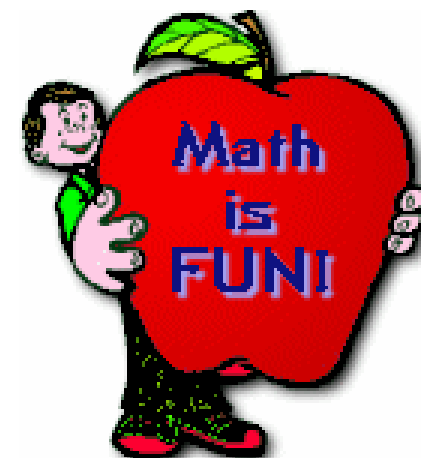

Homework Assignments

ON-LINE GRADING:

Test Scores= 50%

Quizzes=30%

Homework=20%
