CHALLENGE PROGRAM CRITERIA*

3rd Grade:

The student has 120 or higher CogAT (Cognitive Ability) SAS Composite Score (avg. of last 3 years) AND the student meets 2 out of 3 of the following criteria:

- 90% or higher ITBS Core Total Score (average of last 3 years)
- 90% or higher AIMS Web Score
- 38 pts. or higher Teacher Rating Score

4th and 5th Grades:

The student has 120 or higher CogAT (Cognitive Ability) SAS Composite Score (avg. of last 3 years) AND the student meets 3 out of 4 of the following criteria:

- 90% or higher ITBS Core Total Score (average of last 3 years)
- 90% or higher AIMS Web Score
- E (Exceeds) Average ISAT Score
- 38 pts. or higher Teacher Rating Score

6th, 7th, and 8th Grades:

The student has 120 or higher CogAT (Cognitive Ability) SAS Composite Score (avg. of last 3 years) AND the student meets 2 out of 3 of the following criteria:

- 90% or higher ITBS Core Total Score (average of last 3 years)
- E (Exceeds) Average ISAT Score
- 38 pts. or higher Teacher Rating Score

*Students who entered the Challenge Program based on these criteria last year (2008-2009) will automatically be eligible for participation in the program this year (2009-2010). They will be re-evaluated every 3 years.
