4. Title Page (Print 2 – 1 for the front of your binder, 1 for in your binder)
5. Table of Contents (Print 1 for your binder)
6. Acknowledgements (Print 1 for your binder)
7. Purpose & Hypothesis (Print 2 – 1 for board, 1 for binder)
8. Review of Literature (Print 1 for your binder)
9. Materials & Procedure (Print 2 – 1 for board, 1 for binder)
10. Graphs (Print 2 – 1 for board, 1 for binder)
11. Conclusion (Print 2 – 1 for board, 1 for binder)
12. Bibliography (Print 1 for your binder)
