

Jr. High Discipline Policy



Students & Guardians,

Students in Jr. High will receive 8 Bulldog tickets at the beginning of each quarter. Students will have to forfeit a ticket to a staff member for infractions such as:

1. Not prepared for class; including extra trips to student's locker
2. Improper behavior and/or language at any time
3. Not following directions
4. Not bringing back a test that needs to be signed
5. No Homework; including reading log for Accelerated Reader
6. No P.E. uniform

Steps can also be issued to a student for severe discipline issues that include, BUT are not limited to:

1. Not respecting people/property/stealing/cheating
2. Inappropriate language/not telling the truth/

When all 8 tickets have been forfeited, a student receives a step for all infractions. Steps that are issued have the following consequences:

- Step 1: Student meeting with Superintendent/Principal and phone call home.
Step 2: Student meeting with Superintendent/Principal, phone call home and after school detention on the next detention night.
Step 3: Phone call home and meeting with Superintendent/Principal, parent and student, and after school detention on the next detention night.
Step 4: Student and parent meeting with the administrator and all day in-school suspension.
Step 5: Further disciplinary action as deemed necessary.

Students must not receive a step in order to qualify for the end of the quarter reward. Because receiving a step is a serious offense, any student that has received a step, even though they still have tickets remaining, will not be eligible for the quarterly reward.
ALL TICKETS MUST REMAIN IN THE STUDENTS' BINDERS. (Loss of tickets will cost one ticket to replace.)

Homework Headquarters and Reading Nights are available on designated nights. Students that lose more than three tickets due to homework issues or do not make their intended accelerated reading goal, will be required to attend Homework Headquarters and/or Reading Night as needed. Teachers may refer students for either of these programs.

***Detention nights are Tuesdays and Thursdays. Mrs. Zurliene & Mrs. Becker will handle all discipline infractions.**

We have read the above guidelines and understand the discipline system. If we have any questions, we will ask a teacher or administrator. Students are responsible for their tickets and should not mess with anyone else's tickets.
