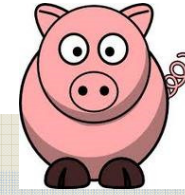

What Does Pig Do?

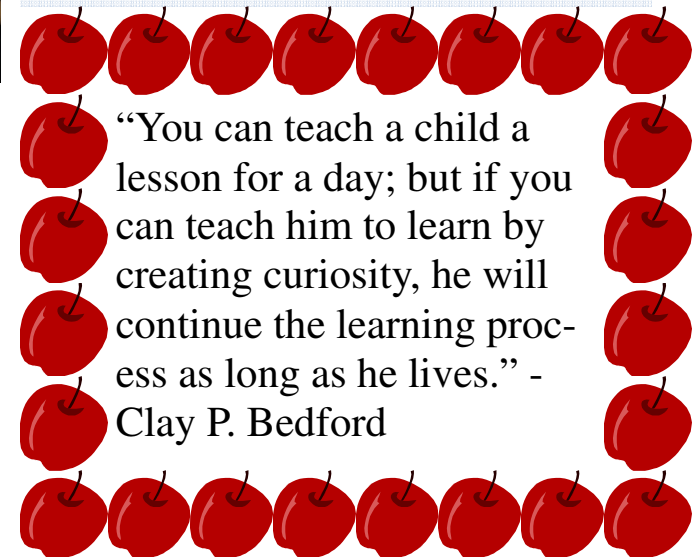
