### MRS. BECKER'S NOTES

We have successfully completed another week of in person learning. Our COVID related absentee rate was high this week, but as we made our way through the week, there was a slow but steady decline.

The daily absentee rate is posted to the district website every day. Just look for "The Daily Update" article on the left hand side of the homepage. Absentee rates for the week of January 18 are:

Tuesday, January 19: 12.13%

Wednesday, January 20: 11.72%

Thursday, January 21: 10.34%

Friday, January 22: 7.53%

**Current 10 Day Rolling Average: 8.07%**

The goal is to keep our students healthy so the 10 day rolling average remains below 10%.

As of today, we have:

- 0 students on quarantine due to potential exposure in school.
- 7 students on quarantine due to potential exposure outside of school.
- 2 staff members on quarantine due to potential exposure outside of school.
- 3 students on quarantine due to a positive COVID result. Both positive cases from this week were students that had been on quarantine for 4 or more days, thus no students had to be sent home due to potential exposure at school.

To keep our numbers below the 10% threshold, we need to be mindful of the following:

- Please keep any children with symptoms at home and communicate the child's symptoms to the office.
- If someone in the home tests for COVID, all children are to be kept home from school until the test results have been reported.

Thank you to all of our families for accepting without complaint the COVID guidelines that we are being asked to enforce. We understand that the guidelines are complicated and oftentimes result in hardship for our families.
