We have successfully completed another week of in person learning, and it was a fantastic week.

The daily absentee rate is posted to the district website every day. Just look for 'The Daily Update' article on the left hand side of the homepage. Absentee rates for the week of January 4 are:

Monday, January 4: 5.86%
Tuesday, January 5: 5.60%
Wednesday, January 6: 4.18%
Thursday, January 7: 4.31%
Friday, January 8: 3.35%

Current 5 Day Rolling Average: 4.66%

The goal is to keep our students healthy so the absentee rate remains below 10%.

As of today, we have:

- 0 students on quarantine due to potential exposure in school.
- 3 students on quarantine due to potential exposure outside of school.
- 3 staff members on quarantine due to potential exposure outside of school.
- 1 student positive COVID test result.
- 1 staff member positive COVID test result.

The positive COVID cases occurred towards the very end of Christmas Break. The individuals had not been at school, so there was no opportunity for exposure in the building.

To keep our numbers below the 10% threshold, we need to be mindful of the following:

- Please keep any children with symptoms at home and communicate the child's symptoms to the office.
- If someone in the home tests for COVID, all children are to be kept home from school until the test results have been reported.
