MRS. BECKER'S NOTES

While we have successfully completed another week of school, it was anything but normal. We send a BIG thank you out to our families for helping the students through their E-learning activities this week. Once we get our revised 2020-21 school calendar approved by the Regional Office of Education and the Illinois State Board of Education, we will share the updated school calendar with you.

The one good thing to come out of the crazy weather is that a majority of our students who were on quarantine are now back at school, and our absentee rate is the best it has been since early October.

The daily absentee rate is posted to the district website every day. Just look for 'The Daily Update' article on the left hand side of the homepage. Absentee rates for the week of February 15 are:

Friday, February 19: 2.09%

Current 10 Day Rolling Average: 8.23%

The goal is to keep our students healthy so the absentee rate remains below 10%.

As of today, we have:

- 0 students on quarantine due to potential exposure in school.
- 5 students on quarantine due to potential exposure outside of school.
- 0 students/staff on quarantine due to a positive COVID test.

To keep our numbers below the 10% threshold, we need to be mindful of the following:

- Please keep any children with symptoms at home and communicate the child's symptoms to the office.
- If someone in the home tests for COVID, all children are to be kept home from school until the test results have been reported.



Pattern Day has been moved to Thursday, February 25. The students, faculty, and staff are encouraged to wear patterned apparel to school.
