## The Weekly Crumbs What's Cracking with Mrs. Graham

**5th Grade Math:** Students will continue learning dividing multi-digit whole numbers, standard 5.NBT.6. There will be a classwork grade this week.

**6th Grade Math:** Students will wrap up standard 6.NS.6 and have a quiz this week. After the quiz, the students will begin working on standard 6.NS.7, which includes ordering rational numbers.

**7th Grade Math:** Students will continue working on linear expressions (standard 7.EE.1). There will be a quiz this week. After the quiz, students will begin working on equivalent expressions with real-world contexts (standard 7.EE.2).

**Study Island:** The next goal is due November 20! Make sure to keep track of due dates.

**8th grade math:** Students will take a test on Monday over linear equations in slope-intercept form and unit rates.(8.EE.5 and 6) Students will begin standard 8.EE.7 which includes solving complex equations in one variable.

**Algebra:** Students will take a classwork grade over transformations of functions on Monday (HSF-BF.B.3). Then we will be diving into chapter 6 concepts which include solving systems of equations with multiple strategies. (HSA-REI.C.5 and HSA-REI.C.6)
